Non-Regular Conformation Classes

Additional—Involving Single Dog Entries (sexes divided)

Winners of these classes, unless otherwise defeated, will compete for Best of Variety

Veteran Class: Seven (7) years of age and over

Field Trial Class: Open to all dogs/bitches who have received points at AKC Field Trials as of the closing date

Dual Champion Class: Open to all dogs/bitches who are Field & Conformation champions as of the closing date

Note: Effective: June 28, 2023 the American Kennel Club allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans Class, Field Trial Class and Dual Champion Class at Independent Specialty Shows, and are eligible for competition in Best of Breed Competition. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

Parade of Veterans & Title Holders-MWDC Sunday Shows only

Dogs entered in the Parade MAY NOT be entered in another class in the Sunday shows. A Rosette imprinted with the dog's name will be awarded to each entrant. Entry form must state "Parade of Veterans & Titleholders." Entry form and fees must be received by the shows closing date. Please submit a separate page with the dog's name and titles clearly printed or typewritten as you would like them printed on the award. Please also include a brief biography for your dog, no more than 125 words. These will be included in the catalog. There will also be a table display. Bring a photo for display - please no larger than 8 x 10.

VETERANS: All Dachshunds, 7 years of age and older. The purpose is to celebrate the older Veteran dogs. Entrants in the Veterans Parade need not hold any AKC titles.

TITLEHOLDERS: All Dachshunds with an AKC Title.

(Non-competitive) Entry Fee \$15.00.

Awards of Merit-MWDC Sunday Shows only. At the discretion of the judge, up to two (2) dogs from the Best of Variety Competition may be awarded an Award of Merit. A Rosette will be given to each dog receiving an Award of Merit.

Junior Showmanship-MWDC Sunday Shows Only

Novice Class

For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. A Best Junior win with competition counts as one win toward moving to Open.

Open Class

For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice & Open Classes are divided by age: 9 to 12 years (Junior), 12 to 15 years (Intermediate),

15 to 18 years (Senior) Master Class

This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Best Junior Handler & Reserve Best Junior Handler, Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at (919) 233-9767. Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. Bitches in season are not eligible. At Specialty shows, dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series- MWDC Sunday Shows Only

(Remember to check the box on the entry form!)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Variety.
- If the Best of Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Variety.
- If neither the Best of Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If the regular show Best of Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Variety including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Variety for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winners are ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handler's organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

**A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

Notice To Exhibitors

- Coffee and breakfast snacks will be available Saturday and Sunday until 9 AM, compliments of the DFCV and MWDC members and friends. A food truck will be available each day. Ice Cream will be available Sunday afternoon following the last variety, compliments of MWDC.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Licensed Events.
- Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- All persons are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Anyone not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave the show grounds. There will be no smoking inside the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. *Proof of Rabies Vaccination is recommended.*
- **PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.** DFCV and MWDC reserve the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending this show hereby waive any claim for damages against DFCV and MWDC or their members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
- Exhibitors providing email addresses will receive all communication, including confirmation and judging schedule through email

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host clubs, Georjie's Dog Events and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

COVID Information

Entries are processed in the order that they are received at the address of the Show Secretary. **The checks must be payable to Georjie's Dog Events, and not to the club(s).**

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the back of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees, postdated checks, returned checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Refunds of \$8 or less will not be issued due to the cost of processing.

PLEASE make your entries correct and legible. Illegible entries cannot be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Agents are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6). Each Owner/Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at the show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the form. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors, or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. No refund for duplicate entries. No entry will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry, \$3.00 for each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Entry fees will not be refunded, in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Show Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. - (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering.
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
- Mixed Breed Dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
