NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. A recording fee of .50 cents and a Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, obedience trial or tracking test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.
