## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION Classes and Divisions

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: <u>Junior</u>-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; <u>Intermediate</u>-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; <u>Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.</u>

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors

meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

## **Eligibility and Regulations**

Junior Showmanship at this show is open only to Basset Hounds. Dogs may be ILP, Full or Limited-Registered to compete in Junior Showmanship Classes, additionally, spayed and neutered specimens are eligible for competition. The dog must be entered in one of the classes associated with the event or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. An eligible dog other than the one entered may be substituted. Such substitutions must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. The junior must have the AKC number of the substitute dog. All such substitutions must be made with the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show.

## BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.

A Junior is limited to one substitution at a dog show. If one of the owners of the dog is a judge, the dog may be entered in the Junior Showmanship Only to be exhibited by the Junior at an event where the judge is judging classes other than Junior Showmanship.

A dog that has been rejected, dismissed or excused by the veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused, may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. Entries for Regular Junior Showmanship Classes shall close at the same time that entries close for this show.

Winning First Place in an Open Junior Showmanship Class at this show may qualify or count towards qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on the eligibility requirements for Limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, write to AKC, Event Plans, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department. (919)816-3776. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

#### **AWARDS OF MERIT**

At the conclusion of the Best of Breed Judging, the judge may, at their discretion, award up to Five (5) Awards of Merit of the specials entry. The Judge is not obligated to award any Awards of Merit, if he/she feels there are not any dogs or bitches in competition worthy of this award. All dogs competing in the Best of Breed competition are eligible for this award, with the exception of the Best of Breed.

### FOUR TO SIX MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION (BHCGS Show)

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows

## Entry and Eligibility Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/ weekend.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

## **AKC National Owner-Handled Series**

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers\*. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by professional handlers meet the requirments for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of the entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog.

Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: A \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee and \$.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). These fees are collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club.

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES is WEDNESDAY, NOON, August 14, 2024 after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or changed except as provided for in Ch. 11, Sec. 6, AKC Rules.

MAIL ALL ENTRIES with fees payable to: Georjie's Dog Events PO Box 21352 Salem OR 97307. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, will be required to pay a fee of \$25 per check and all items for which check or checks were issued shall then be paid by cash, money order or cashier's check.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE or Entries Received Without Fees will not be accepted.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors on entry blanks and for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on reverse side of Official AKC entry form are NOT acceptable.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly.

There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. In case of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other acts beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ENTERED to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and its Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling or intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

THE CLUB RESERVES the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

ALL AWARDS WILL BE MADE IN THE JUDGING RING to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the rightful recipient of the award. No awards will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.

ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS SHOW hereby waive any claim for damages against the Emerald Empire Basset Hound Fanciers, Inc., the Basset Hound Club of Greater Seattle, Inc., their members or agents, or in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
