NOTICE: Juniors who win a third Novice Class with competition present, after closing of entries for a show, ARE REQUIRED TO TRANSFER their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class BY NOTIFYING the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at (919) 816-3776 or email: juniors@akc.org.

Entry blank must be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Dogs shown in Puppy Sweepstakes on **Friday morning** must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class".

The following classes will be provided for both Dogs and Bitches

Puppy, 6 months & under 9 months

Junior, 12 months & under 18 months

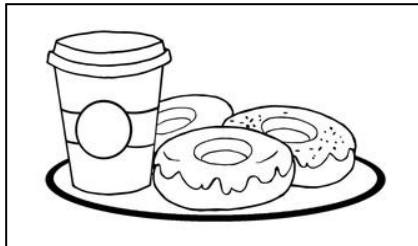

- No smoking is allowed inside the building. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on Show Grounds.
- Exhibitors may park around building & in building's lot. There may be restrictions near other buildings if other events are taking place during our show weekend.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor the Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed, Variety, or Class judging.
- All cash or checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced cash or checks will not be replaced. The Event Secretary is not able to cash checks.
- All Prizes must be claimed the day of the show(s). None will be mailed.
- The Show Giving Club and the Show Secretary assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property.
- No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent or covered patio in which these shows are conducted.

Owners/Agents are responsible for Entry Form accuracy. Neither catalog corrections, nor entry fee refunds will be made after the published closing date for these shows. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practical. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Event Secretary.

Email, telephone or fax entries can NOT be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and/or photocopies without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. ALL ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entry Fee will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judged or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. Entry fees will not be refunded if the Show(s) cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

ENTRY INFORMATION

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: 6 PM ET, Wednesday, 2026

at the home of the Event Secretary, after which time entries cannot be accepted, can be substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules & Regulations.

Entries without signature, fees or agreement on the back of the entry form will not be accepted. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

An AKC Recording Fee & Event Service Fee of \$4.50 are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the Show, The Recording and the Event Service Fees are collected on the first entry only (American Kennel club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). These AKC fees are included in the Entry Fees stated in this premium.

NEW EXHIBITOR BRIEFING

There will be a new exhibitor briefing each day 45 minutes prior to the start of judging. This briefing is designed to help understand how a dog show works. We will explain the duties of the Event Secretary, The AKC Executive Field Staff, the event committee and the ring steward, an explanation of dog show classes, points computation and verification of Placements.

Opportunities for Majors at Specialties:

The modification provides all specialty clubs the option for the Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch to earn a three-point major provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex totals at least twice the number required for a five-point major, in the region in which the event is held. Previously this option was only available at a breed's National Specialty. Clubs must opt-out on their event application if they do not want this option available at their specialty show. This option is available for events held on or after July 3, 2024.
